

The main design principles that the studio intended to implement, refer to the highlighting of all the original and authentic materials and techniques blended together with contemporary technologies and world-renowned statement furniture in order to create a comfortable bespoke environment.


The approach was both simple and complex following a minimal intervention on the historical aspects, with a broad spectrum of contemporary solutions only to highlight and complement each other.

Why did you choose Aldo Bernardi's products and what challenges did they help you overcome?

« The use of Aldo Bernardi products was a design intention and also a technical solution considering the specific particularities of the property. The systems that we used blend very well with the overall condition and aspect of the house adding value through the materials and technologies that are particular to the brand. The main challenge was to create an electrical and lighting system in the restaurant part of the project which would allow us to keep intact the valuable paintings on the ceiling and the texture and technique of the walls plastering - an old technique meant to remain impeccable traditional plaster tempered with lime ».

The architect Stefano Carlone and the designer Vincenzo Berlingerio of K1artStudio have chosen Aldo Bernardi's creations for the renovation project of the pastry shop "Il vero desiderio" in Mola di Bari, a sweet paradise on Puglia's coast.

K1artStudio is an architecture, design and graphics studio, made up of a team of young talents who put creativity, experience and passion at the service of the most demanding clients. Which is their mission? Transforming every work, idea, brand and product into a complete and exclusive project.

We love taking care of our projects and of the smallest details, trying to include, in addition to architectural and interior design, other services strictly related to the project, such as graphic design, product design, marketing and web development".

The project

The owners of "Il vero Desiderio" wanted to renovate the historic pastry shop in the center of Mola di Bari through a targeted intervention which would recall the atmosphere of the English Bakeries, with a shabby-chic style, but fit into the specific context. K1artStudio has designed a completely revolutionized space, with an overall vision that allows you to get out of the classic schemes. Lighting played an important role in the work plan. The aim was to enhance the original barrel vault present in the room and, at the same time, enlighten the environment with a product that, in its formal simplicity, could become a characterizing element. The choice fell on 5 versions of Aldo Bernardi suspension lamp "Fate", in matt white ceramic.

Ex-convent of San Giacomo

Sardegna, Italy

The role of Aldo Bernardi creations in the redevelopment of the ex-convent of San Giacomo

The engineer Andrea Magario and the architect Erika Terlini of Studio TEM chose Aldo Bernardi's creations for the lighting of the exconvent of San Giacomo, in Nughedu Santa Vittoria (OR), now transformed into a multifunctional accommodation facility. Studio TEM is an Architecture and Engineering studio, specialized in the Residential and Public Works. In particular, it deals with construction management, site safety, interior and plant design, with particular attention to sustainability. "We have been dealing with sustainability since the foundation of our team: we are convinced that good architecture must be at the service of people and respectful of the environment in which we live. This approach is the key to our work." - Studio TEM

The project

The Municipality of Nughedu Santa Vittoria (OR) has commissioned to Studio TEM the redevelopment of the ex-convent of San Giacomo, converted into a multifunctional accommodation facility. The project included, among other interventions, the reconstruction of the electrical and lighting system. Considering the historical-artistic constraints and the desire not to damage the walls with invasive interventions, they have chosen an external solution with the products of the Aldo Bernardi ceramic line and the braided cable with cotton fiber covering. In addition, lighting fixtures were installed in imitation of the old traditional lamps.





The collaboration with Aldo Bernardi

We interviewed the engineer Andrea Magario about the aspects that led him to choose Aldo Bernardi's creations and to collaborate with our company.

What is the advantage of choosing an Aldo Bernardi lighting system / product?

« Aldo Bernardi solutions can be easily integrated with existing structures, imitating an old electrical system, but with current quality and regulatory standards. There are not many manufacturers of this type of appliances and components. This is why we found ourselves very well collaborating with Aldo Bernardi. »

What are the current trends and how can Aldo Bernardi respond to these market demands?

« The current trends - in the lighting sector - in my opinion are different, but in the Italian market there is no lack of typological recovery interventions. The Aldo Bernardi lines can also fit into shabby chic, industrial interventions, very popular especially in the restaurant and hospitality sector.

N.B Aldo Bernardi produces and sells the individual components that make up the system, which must subsequently be adapted to regulatory standards and certified by a qualified electrician. »

What was your customer's need?

The project was born from the need of a young couple, lovers of art and design and fond of fitness and outdoor activities. The request was to enable them to cultivate all these passions aboard their yacht. For this reason the shipowner did not want the elements on board to seem trendy and could go easily out of fashion, but on the contrary he desidered everything to be harmoniously integrated with the client's lifestyle.

What solution did you find and why?

The search for a timeless style, where modernity is combined in harmonious contrast with classicism led Aldo Bernardi to design an exposed lighting system. Together with the Paszkowski studio, which oversaw the interior decoration choices, we followed the entire development of the lighting project step by step. The industrial style of these light installations frames each room and enhances the furnishing elements. The pipes, the switch plates, the lighting fixtures and the sockets in dark burnished brass - made especially for this project - are exactly what the client was looking for. At the same time, the solutions proposed by Aldo Bernardi respond perfectly to the philosophy of Cantiere delle Marche, since the yachts we build are not vacuously luxurious objects, but boats of proven quality.

What makes Aldo Bernardi different from other brands?

The products supplied are the result of a custom design and high-level craftsmanship, the result of great experience. This is the perfect combination we are looking for in a supplier and partner. Furthermore, the interpersonal relationship is a very important aspect for Cantiere delle Marche: we are often chosen for the human component, which still makes the difference for many clients, and we too seek the same synergy with our suppliers. We found it in Aldo and Patrizia, with whom we found ourselves in great harmony from the beginning. The proposed solutions, in fact, were the result of an intense collaboration and a dense exchange of ideas that led to an excellent result, both in terms of product quality and the final decorative effect.

Which solution did you choose and why?

« Due to the customer's needs, we intervened when the project was almost completed, adapting our work to the existing electrical system. Casa Abbona is an old renovated Langa farmhouse. Aldo Bernardi's lamps and lighting systems matched perfectly to a location of this type. »

What is the added value of installing an Aldo Bernardi product?

«Aldo Bernardi's systems can also be installed in places where, for a thousand reasons, the electrical system has not been studied in the best possible way during the design phase. Their systems, in fact, can easily adapt to existing structures or, if this is not possible, be customized based on the specific needs of the customer.»

What makes Aldo Bernardi different from other brands?

«Aldo Bernardi was the first to reinvent the products of the Italian past times, giving designers the opportunity to best express their creativity in the field of lighting in rustic environments.
